## 2014 HONORIFIC AWARDS NOMINATIONS

Henry M. Stratton Medal Nomination Deadline: July 2, 2013

Named for the late Henry Maurice Stratton, founder of the medical publishing house of Grune and Stratton with Mr. L.H. Grunebaum, this award is intended to honor an individual, age 51 or above (at time of nomination), who has made outstanding contributions to hematology. ASH presents this award to two individuals annually, one who has made outstanding contributions in basic science and one for achievements in clinical research or translational research. The individual being nominated for this award is being nominated for: (1) outstanding contributions in basic science, or (2) outstanding contributions in clinical or translational research

Clinical research is defined by the definition accepted in the Institute of Medicine (IOM) Clinical Research Roundtable as T1 (clinical translation of a basic science discovery to prevention, diagnosis or treatment of a hematological disease) or T2 (the translation of results from clinical studies into everyday clinical practice and health decision making).

Nominations <u>must include</u> the completed nomination form and a letter of nomination summarizing his or her contributions to hematology, including the reason for the nomination. In addition a current copy of the nominee's CV must be submitted with the nomination form. This award will be presented at the 2014 ASH Annual Meeting. <u>Only one form may be submitted per nominee</u>.

NOTE: Nominees and nominator must be members of ASH.
