Trainee Council Application
Submission Deadline: April 2, 2012

Nominating materials must include all of the following:

1. Completed application form.
 2. A letter of nomination from the MD applicant's training program director or the PhD applicant's division chief/department chair.
The letter of nomination should include:
 - Reasons supporting the candidate's application
 - Assessment of candidate qualifications (including clinical, research, education, service-related) relevant to participation in the council
 - Potential for leadership and contribution
 - Confirmation of applicant's enrolment in a hematology, hematology/oncology, or hematology-related training program that consists of more than two years, in order to be concurrent with the two-year term on the council
 3. A brief personal statement from the trainee.
The personal statement should include:
 - Reasons for wishing to participate in the Council
 - Evidence of leadership abilities
 - Committee/service experience
 - "Other" qualifications or achievements that would be of value to the Council
 - Any ideas or proposals that could be brought to the Council
 4. The trainee nominee's CV.
- Applications must be submitted electronically to training@hematology.org by **11:59 pm EST April 2, 2012**.
 - Only electronic submissions will be accepted.
 - All submissions **MUST** include the required documents listed above, in the order above, and be **submitted as one PDF file**.
 - The file should be named in the following format: TC Application Lastname-Firstname 2012.pdf
 - Applications not formatted correctly with missing or incorrect required documents or information will not be considered.

Eligibility to Serve on the ASH Trainee Council

Trainees in accredited hematology, hematology/oncology, or hematology-related training programs that are currently in their first year of training at the time of application are eligible for nomination by their training program directors. PhD trainees in all hematology-related disciplines are eligible for nomination by their division chief/department chair.

All nominees **must** be in their fellowship training program during the 2012-2014 academic years (July 1 - June 30) to be eligible.

Nominees must be MDs or MD/PhDs from accredited hematology, hematology/oncology, or hematology-related fellowship training programs. PhD nominees must be in a hematology post-doctoral training program.

Nominees **must** be [Associate members](#) of ASH at the time of application. Applications for new associate membership should be submitted no later than by February 29. Dues must be paid by time of Council application. To verify your membership status, please log on to the [membership section](#) of the ASH website. Trainees who exhibit leadership qualities and a high potential for a successful career in hematology or a hematology-related discipline are desired candidates.

Each training program may submit only one nomination per year.
