


ASH MINORITY RESIDENT HEMATOLOGY **AWARD PROGRAM**


Promoting underrepresented minority residents in hematology through invaluable research experience and mentorship



The ASH Minority Resident Hematology Award Program (MRHAP) offers a unique opportunity for first- and second-year medical residents to get exposure to the field of hematology through hands-on research guided by ASH research and career-development mentors.

Apply to advance your hematology research experience!

Meet prominent leaders in the field of hematology and network with more than 25,000 physicians, scientists, educators, trainees, and industry professionals from around the world at the ASH annual meeting.





Work with an ASH mentor on your research project. Program participants are also paired with an ASH member who serves as a career-development mentor throughout their residency.



Present your research during a special event for recipients of ASH Minority Recruitment Initiative award programs and discuss your findings with ASH leadership, peers, and other annual meeting attendees.

Receive \$5,000 to support your research experience, a \$2,000 travel allowance to attend the ASH annual meeting in early December, and complimentary ASH membership, which includes subscriptions to Blood and The Hematologist, the Society's journal and newsletter.
