HONORIFIC AWARD NOMINATIONS

Wallace H. Coulter Award for Lifetime Achievement in Hematology

Named for Wallace Henry Coulter, a prolific inventor who made important contributions to hematology and to ASH, this award is the Society's highest honor. It is bestowed on an individual who has demonstrated a lifetime commitment and outstanding contribution to hematology, and who has made a significant impact on education, research, and/or practice. During his lifetime, Mr. Coulter was a strong supporter of ASH; to date, he is the only person to receive the American Society of Hematology Distinguished Service Award for his enormous contribution to the field of hematology.

Nominations must include the completed nomination form and a letter of nomination summarizing the nominee's contributions to hematology, including the reason for the nomination. In addition, a copy of the nominee's current CV and NIH biosketch, annotated with "Contributions to Science," if available, must be submitted with the nomination form.

Nominations for the ASH Honorific Awards are accepted throughout the year. Any nomination submitted prior to the award deadline will be considered for the current review cycle. Nominations submitted after the award deadline will be considered for the subsequent review cycle.

NOTE: Nominees and nominators are not required to be members of ASH.
