HONORIFIC AWARD NOMINATIONS
William Dameshek Prize

Named for the late Dr. William Dameshek, a past president of the Society and the first editor of its journal, *Blood*, this award is given to an individual, no more than 50 years of age (at time of nomination) who, like Dr. Dameshek, has made outstanding contributions in hematology.

Nominations must include the completed nomination form and a letter of nomination summarizing the nominee's contributions to hematology, including the reason for the nomination. In addition, a copy of the nominee's current CV and NIH biosketch, annotated with "Contributions to Science," if available, must be submitted with the nomination form.

Nominations for the ASH Honorific Awards are accepted throughout the year. Any nomination submitted prior to the award deadline will be considered for the current review cycle. Nominations submitted after the award deadline will be considered for the subsequent review cycle.

NOTE: Nominees and nominators must be members of ASH.
