HONORIFIC AWARD NOMINATIONS

Henry M. Stratton Medal

Named for the late Henry Maurice Stratton, founder of the medical publishing house of Grune and Stratton with Mr. L.H. Grunebaum, this award is intended to honor an individual, age 51 or above (at time of deadline), who has made outstanding contributions to hematology. ASH presents this award to two individuals annually, one who has made outstanding contributions in basic science and one for achievements in clinical research or translational research. The individual being nominated for this award is being nominated for (1) outstanding contributions in basic science, or (2) outstanding contributions in clinical or translational research.

Clinical research is defined by the definition accepted in the Institute of Medicine (IOM) Clinical Research Roundtable as T1 (clinical translation of a basic science discovery to prevention, diagnosis or treatment of a hematological disease) or T2 (the translation of results from clinical studies into everyday clinical practice and health decision making).

Nominations must include the completed nomination form and a letter of nomination summarizing the nominee's contributions to hematology, including the reason for the nomination. In addition, a copy of the nominee's current CV and NIH biosketch, annotated with "Contributions to Science," if available, must be submitted with the nomination form.

Nominations for the ASH Honorific Awards are accepted throughout the year. Any nomination submitted prior to the award deadline will be considered for the current review cycle. Nominations submitted after the award deadline will be considered for the subsequent review cycle.
